We are writing this letter because we are appalled by the amount of plastic bags you give us, every week, in our bread delivery.

We are really grateful for the fresh bread you provide as it makes delicious toast for our Breakfast Club. However, we feel you give us too much plastic that ends up being thrown away. Each loaf of bread comes in its own plastic bag and then the loaves are put inside an even bigger plastic bag! Each week, Greggs is giving us over 50 bags. We're sure you'd agree this is a lot of waste that ends up in landfill...

Single use plastic bags are very difficult to recycle. At Hawthorn Primary we are working hard to reduce our single-use plastic consumption. We have made eco-bricks, created bottle top murals, stopped laminating and banned glitter. In a recent eco audit it was clear to see plastic bags are one of our main items being thrown away. We think you could help us reduce this problem area and stop using plastic bags to package your bread and find an alternative.
