Energy efficient light bulbs reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Also flip the light switch off when you leave the room!

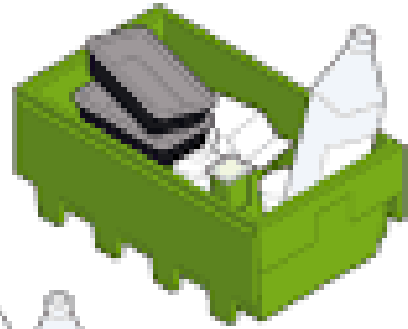
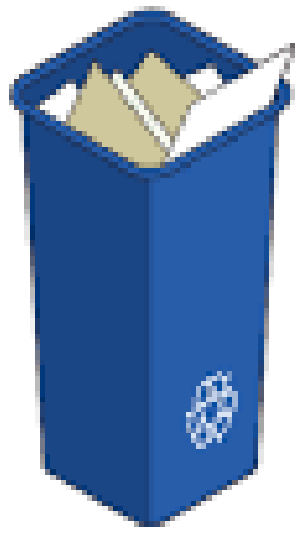

You can help from home by separating your recycling

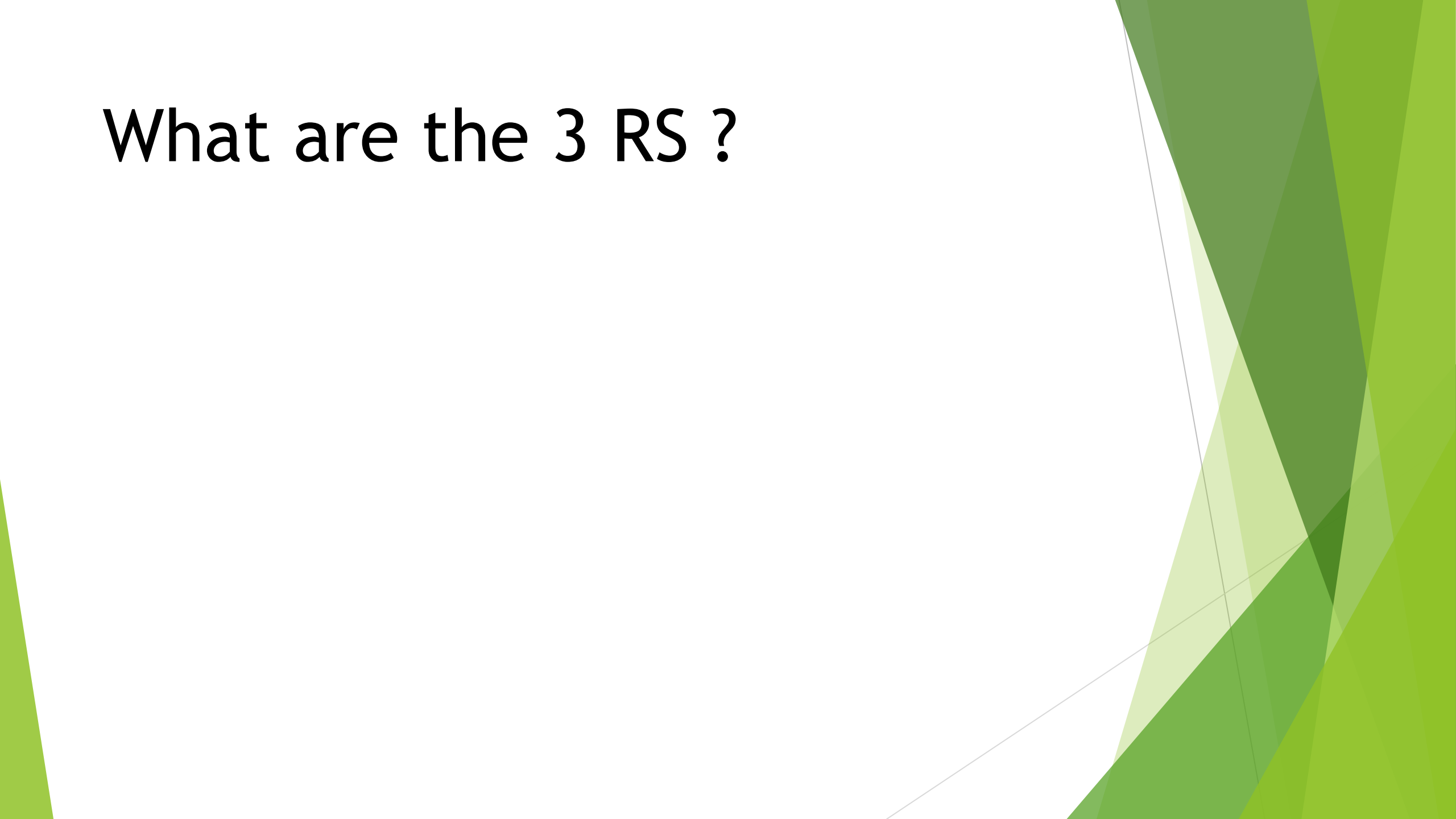
What do you put in different bins ?

in the green bins (Not milk cartons)

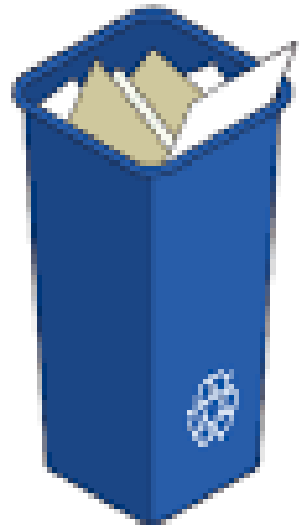


Recycle old whiteboard pens. You need to put your pens into a box for recycling. Ask your teacher if you do not have a box.

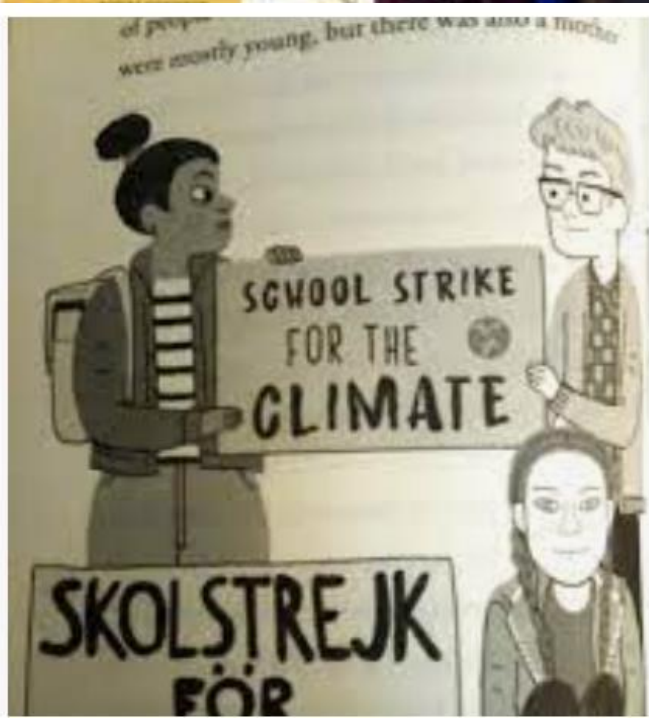
Who is Greta?
