## Plastic Clever School action plan

What problem plastic(s) are you going to tackle?

E.g. Single use bottles and cups

- Single use plastic bottles brought in by children
- Individual milk cartons (drank by reception children)
- Glue sticks
- Continue to use reusable lunch boxes for pick'n'mix school lunches.
- Continue to use reusable cups at lunch time.

What can you do to reduce it?

E.g. Get everyone to use a reusable bottle instead

- We will encourage children to use reusable bottles.
- We will find out whether it is possible to get milk in cardboard cartons rather than plastic.
- We will reduce the number of glue sticks given to each class every term.
- Continue to use reusables in the kitchen.

What help will you need?

E.g. Help to spread the message to pupils, staff and parents. Also, we'll need to speak to Mr. X to ask to stop ordering the single use cups.

- Newsletters and class letters will encourage the use of reusable bottles.
- Office staff to contact milk supplier.
- Office staff to manage glue sticks.
- Kitchen staff to manage/continue using reusable plastic.

How will you know you've been successful?

Everyone has a reusable bottle and the school has stopped ordering the cups.

- Children will be using reusable bottles.
- Individual milk cartons for reception will be cardboard (if this is possible).
- The school will be using/throwing away fewer glue sticks.
- Reusables will continue to be used by the kitchen staff.
